

Westport Light State Park – Westport Golf LLC Proposal Comments

December 19, 2022 – Jan 4, 2023

I live near the lighthouse and I'm against the golf course project. Thanks ¹
What is going to become of the paved trail that runs along the coast? What is going to become of the area used by the surfers? ²
What would happen to the Coast Guard Campground if Westport Golf Links is approved? ³
I was shocked and saddened by the proposal to change Westport Light State Park into a links golf course. I understand that WLSP is one of the Recreation Concession Area parks - however, this goes far beyond rational understanding of "concessions" in your RCA designation. Millersylvania State Park is also an RCA park, but they have a seasonal beer garden, snack bar, and kayak rental trailer. Those amenities all seem reasonable to add to a park to provide park visitors with opportunities to play outside and have refreshments while they are enjoying the nature in the park. Turning WLSP, a largely undisturbed park with habitat for wildlife -- complete with interdunal wetlands -- into a links golf course ⁴

The proposed golf course on the Westhaven / Lighthouse property will be hugely beneficial to the community in a number of ways. The current walking trail, which is paved, must stay as is, as the course is planned. This asphalt trail allows many people to access the views and our area. If this were to be removed or replaced with another surface, it would take away access to many families and those in wheelchairs. I myself, need a level path to walk on.</p> <p>The other concern I have is housing for the employees of the course. For those earning less than \$25 per hour, there are few to no options for living. I believe it is important to hire a local workforce and ensure there is affordable housing available. This should be a top consideration as the course is planned and hopefully built.</p> <p>Thank you for your time and consideration. ⁵³</p>
<p>I have not seen very much on what this project will do for the community. Westport is growing quickly and there is already so much Westport needs: more parking, more walking/biking/recreation trails, side walks, community recreation center, etc. One golf course is plenty. Rather than adding two golf courses, why not give back to this community by using some</p>

of this area for a community recreation center?

The closest pool and recreation location is Grays Harbor YMCA in Hoquiam approximate 40 minutes away. This coastal community cannot even make sure its children know how to swim since there is no public pool. Add a lap pool, pickleball courts, fitness and weight rooms and you would make this community a healthier community.

Why not add more parking to both Westhaven and Westport Light Parks? Have you been to Westhaven Park or Westport light on a sunny Saturday? The Westhaven park has no overflow parking lots and parking is full by 10 am or earlier. It wouldn't be hard to add another parking area along the road that would allow more people to safely enjoy this area without having to park on Jetty Haul road. More walking/ biking/ recreation trails is also needed. Yes, the lighthouse trail is stunning and wonderful as is but it could use a less windy return loop on the N Forrest street side. There is no complete sidewalk in Westport to safely go from the docks to the grocery store. If you come off of a boat how are you expected to restock on the essentials without getting runover?

The Golf Course sounds wonderful to attract more people from away to this community. But it could also do more for the community that lives in the area if more thought was given to giving back to the community with this project. ⁵⁴

I am a frequent visitor and property owner in Westport, and plan to move there for retirement if the golf course is built. I love and use many of our beautiful Washington State Parks, and have been a Discover Pass holder for years. I think this is exactly the kind of public-private partnership that we need in some of our properties... such a smart direction to go.

Westport Light State Park has great potential, but is not living up to it. The park cannot be enjoyed by many people in its current state... a huge percentage of it is inaccessible and wasted with invasive species. This project will restore and protect the environment, greatly improve the existing activities (walking, surfing, etc.), and really result in something the State of Washington can be proud of.

I believe support for this project should be an obvious choice for anyone who truly knows this park in its existing state AND has taken the time to understand the details of the proposed bonus enhancements and the type of natural, low-impact golf course involved. I am 100% in favor of the proposed golf course project. I love the design parameters of working with the environment instead of molding the environment to suite the course, no pesticides, using native grasses, and a playable course for all levels.

The added concepts of a walking course (instead of golf carts) and public walking paths through the course, combined with the base idea, create a destination location for day trippers and tourists in addition to a golfer's destination.

Please do all you can to move this forward to completion. ⁵⁶

There is no room for anything else on Jetty Haul Road for any

more activity. Please go there any Saturday or Sunday morning in the summer, and see cars parked on both sides of the road all the way to Montesano St. The lot at the jetty is full by 8 or 9am from spring until fall.

The popularity of surfing is exploding, especially in recent years. There are also more and more people fishing and sightseeing, especially in the high season, but also on any sunny weekend all year long. This is the most popular surf spot in Washington state and it is only becoming more popular.

Please don't put this at the currently proposed site. At least consider using the south end of the park where there is much less traffic or at the Grayland area. This proposal would vastly increase traffic in an already very congested area. I saw a grouse on the bike trail and one time saw a pheasant on Jetty Haul Road. I don't see either of those mentioned in the environmental review. Please don't destroy this habitat again.

Also, why is NOTHING posted at the jetty about this proposal? There is a board for notices and unless it was added in the last 2 months, I have not seen any notice about this proposal; I heard about it from a coworker who can't remember how they heard about it. Please be sure the regular users of this gem of a park are not unaware of what is being proposed.⁵⁷

Destroying the natural dunescape would be a huge loss to natural beauty of the park. We come out there twice a year just to get away from man-made structures. There's enough golf courses in the area. To destroy this land to serve relatively small percentage of visitors to Westport would be a shame.⁵⁸
