

Dear Camp Hosts:

The 2018 State Parks Camporee is just around the corner! This year's Camporee will be held at beautiful Cama Beach State Park April 16-18. ***Please note that you must be an approved camp host to attend this event.***

LOCATION: Cama Beach State Park is located on Camano Island. Entering Cama Beach is like stepping into an earlier time. The park was originally a family resort, which had its heyday from the 1930s to the 1950s. It has retained the feel of a bygone era, with rows of cabins, a park store and a large campfire circle for evening socializing. The current state park also features a great hall (the Cama Center) and a café. You can check out the park at www.parks.wa.gov.

ACCOMMODATIONS:

Camping: Cama Beach is not a camping park. Camping will be provided for you at Camano Island State Park Sunday, April 15, thru Wednesday, April 18. We will provide a shuttle between the parks for those who need it. If you want to stay longer or arrive before April 15, you will need to go online at www.parks.wa.us and make a reservation.

Cabins: If you don't want to travel with your RV, I have reserved most of the cabins at Cama Beach for our use. Only a handful of cabins have restrooms, but we have a very nice bathhouse nearby. You will need to bring your bedding, towels and toiletries. These will be assigned on a first-come, first-served basis.

MEALS:

State Parks will provide meals for April 16 thru breakfast on April 18. We should be done by 11:00 a.m. on the 18th. We will have a BBQ potluck Monday night. We will provide burgers, hot dogs, veggie burgers and the fixings and ask that you bring a side dish or dessert.

REGISTRATION: **Please complete and return the registration form by March 10.** If you need special accommodations, please be sure to indicate so on your registration form. We will work with you on your needs once registration is completed.
