Keep Washington Green

LEVEL 1 - LOW (Green)	Fires allowed in all designated fire pits
LEVEL 2 - MEDIUM (Blue)	Wood fires restricted to designated fire pits within select areas of a park. Gas, propane and charcoal allowed.
Level 3 - HIGH (Yellow)	Wood fires restricted to designated fire pits within select areas of a park. Gas and propane allowed. No charcoal allowed.
LEVEL 4 - EXTREME (Orange)	Gas/propane self-contained camping stoves and portable gas/propane fire pits allowed. No charcoal or wood fires allowed.
Level 5 - DANGEROUS (Red)	No open flame of any type, No smoking allowed. Trails and undeveloped areas closed to entry. (Internal RV stoves are allowed)
NO FIRES ANYTIME (Gray)	No Fire Permitted at any time of the year, no facilities.
