<b>LEVEL 1 - LOW (Green)</b>	Fires allowed in all designated fire pits
<b>LEVEL 2 - MEDIUM (Blue)</b>	Wood fires restricted to designated fire pits within select areas of a park. Gas, propane and charcoal allowed.
<b>Level 3 - HIGH (Yellow)</b>	Wood fires restricted to designated fire pits within select areas of a park. Gas and propane allowed. No charcoal allowed.
<b>LEVEL 4 - EXTREME (Orange)</b>	Gas/propane self-contained camping stoves and portable gas/propane fire pits allowed. No charcoal or wood fires allowed.
<b>Level 5 - DANGEROUS (Red)</b>	<b>No open flame of any type, No smoking allowed. Trails and undeveloped areas closed to entry. (Internal RV stoves are allowed)</b>
<b>NO FIRES ANYTIME (Gray)</b>	No Fire Permitted at any time of the year, no facilities.
