Common Climbing Equipment

- Stoppers. Passive protection devices used to place into a natural crack to protect climbers in the event of falling.
- Camalots. Active climbing protection used to place into natural cracks. The camming action expands the device to fill the width of the crack sustaining pressure to protect the climber in the event of a fall.
- Slings. Webbing loops used to wrap around knobs, tree trunks or large rocks to protect the climber or to set up a rappel station.
