This project consisted of improvements to a domestic water pumping system, including selective demolition, removal, and installation of the wellhead, submersible pump, control panel, waterlines, and other miscellaneous work.

Need: The wellhead needed to be raised out of an area of potential river flooding to prevent potential well contamination.
